

ASOSU UNDERGRADUATE SENATE MEETING 02/13/2007
REGULAR MINUTES UNAVAILABLE DUE TO SECRETARY ILLNESS

Brief Summary of Last Senate Meeting

We heard from various budgets that had already been tentatively improved by SIFC.

Significant information included the fact that Counseling and Psychological Services wants to be completely student-funded; which would raise their per-term fee by nearly 6.00; but would essentially save them from potential cuts due to Student Affairs budget shortfall for next year.

We also heard that Athletics will not request a fee-increase this year and that there is a 5.00 decrease in that budget due to the end of the Raising Reser loan period. Todd Stansbury also told us that we would lose 300 baseball seats and go back to the initial 500 due to the really low student attendance last year.

The Athletics Advisory board was advised by Senate that the committee would have to make a presentation to Senate regarding that issue since we, in essence were under contract for 800 seats.

We heard from MU Vice President Bruke Getachew about the MU requesting a small base budget increase and 3 decision packages that included allocating more resources to student clubs, creating salary-parity for MUPC student employees and investing in improvements/upgrades to the MU building.
