BILL TO CENSURE PRESIDENT DAN MCCARTHY FOR QUESTIONABLE CONDUCT IN THE COMMUNITY DURING THE 2005-2006 TERM

WHEREAS, The Associated Students of Oregon State University's Statutes and Constitution clearly outline the duty of the President as
“(to) publicly represent the ASOSU to increase the visibility and influence of the ASOSU on and off campus.”¹

And

“...represent OSU students to the faculty and the public.”²
“...represent ASOSU at official and social functions”³

WHEREAS, The recent conduct of the President calls into serious question, the image and integrity of the office of the President and the nature of his representation of ASOSU as a governing body.

WHEREAS, The Associated Students of Oregon State University Legislative Branch reserves the right to legislate a censure in cases where the conduct of an elected executive official runs contrary to the integrity of his/her office.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE 65th ASOSU UNDERGRADUATE SENATE AND THE 11th ASOSU GRADUATE SENATE THAT

- President Dan McCarthy shall be officially censured by this Senate for his conduct during his term as President for the 2005-2006 school year
- We strongly suggest that President McCarthy to demonstrate his remorse for his actions by engaging in related community service and that he make a report of his progress of such, at the first meeting of Spring Term; 2006.
- No further penalty will be legislated by this Senate FOR THIS SPECIFIC questionable conduct
