**RESOLUTION TO ASK FOR MODIFICATION TO THE
MEMORIAL UNION FOOD POLICY**

- WHEREAS, The Memorial Union is in a synergistic relationship between students and the business enterprises
- WHEREAS, The Memorial Union is student controlled and expanding the food policy is in the interests of students
- WHEREAS, The food policy does take into account campus-wide aspects of diversity and the ability for cultural events to provide their catering or prepare the food themselves.
- WHEREAS, The Leadership of the Memorial Union has one of the most progressive food policies with respect to students rights in the country
- WHEREAS, Advertising the inclusive food policy for students will benefit the student body
- WHEREAS, Continuing the expansion of students' food rights to improve the overall culture, and the cultural diversity of the University, while respecting this unique relationship, is beneficial to all parties

**BE IT HERBY RESOLVED BY THE 65th UNDERGRADUATE SENATE AND
THE 11TH GRADUATE SENATE THAT:**

1. The Memorial Union food policy should continue to expand, where possible, so that events of cultural education and awareness can continue to explore, create, and spread ideas.
2. The Memorial Union food policy should be more clearly outlined in student club orientation, and provide up to date policy that is easily accessible.
3. This policy shall be modified to respect current food handling and health regulations for groups providing self-catering.
4. This resolution, upon passage, shall be presented to the leadership of the Memorial Union as a formal request for the food policy to be modified to reflect the three previous qualifications.
