REQUEST FOR INJUNCTION TO THE ASOSU JUDICIAL COUNCIL
(No. 24.039.c)

[July 31, 2024]

On July 30, 2024, ASOSU Vice President Zachary Kowash filed a request for injunction to Senate Bill 84.05. He believes that certain provisions would go into effect requiring him as Chief Elections Officer to take irreversible and detrimental action before the Council has had the opportunity to hear arguments on the bill. He also argues that since a clear constituency has not been established, he is unable to proceed with a Special Election.

The Council voted unanimously to hear the writ concerning Senate Bill 84.05 (No. 24.038.i) on July 27, 2024.

The Council agrees that this writ should be heard before provisions of the bill are to take effect.

The Council hereby grants a temporary injunction order (TIO) on Senate Bill 84.05, effective 2:00 pm on July 31, 2024. Senate Bill 84.05 shall not go into effect until the Council has handed down an Opinion on No. 24.038.i. The Council will lift the injunction when an Opinion on No. 24.038.i has been handed down.

Carmichael and Chair Jones delivered the opinion of the Council, in which Godfrey and Fraley joined. Councilor Paola dissented.
