b. Reviewing [SB 83.23 "ASOSU Code of Conduct"](#)

- Conduct violations should be more broadly shared to ensure that officers of all branches are well informed
- Pass changes in multiple bills
 - Removing risk for free speech violations should be a priority
 - Requirement for evidence to be presented and a defined appeals process
 - Escalate reports of sexual harassment or violence
 - Violating the university code of conduct doesn't inherently breach the ASOSU Code of Conduct
 - Possibly remove the section -> Violating this code of conduct constitutes a breach of the code
 - Where it applies, where it doesn't apply
