- b. Reviewing [SB 83.23 “ASOSU Code of Conduct”](#)

Focus on appeals process:

Emerson: I like an idea of a Jury that students can opt into during elections

Teaghan: I have concerns that we as students do not have proper training for judging the ethics of a scenario. Should leave certain cases to professionals like office of advocacy or Ombuds

Adison: I like the Jury idea but don't know that it will be practical to implement. A 3 person committee with people from each branch would be a good starting point. Should not be the heads of branches.

Emerson: I think committee is not a bad idea but how do appeals work.

Adison: Committee reviews first but could maybe be referred to a larger body for an appeal.

Emerson: Keeping things anonymous should be prioritized to remove bias.

Adison: Keeping things anonymous would be hard when giving context.

c. Validity of Partial Veto Overrides

Emerson: Think partial veto override would create confusion

Adison: Would maybe strip presidential veto power

Teaghan: That makes sense

d. Reviewing SB 84.10 veto overrides

Emerson and Adison: like the original

Eliza: I have no issue with the proposed amendments

Teaghan: I prefer the amendment suggestion to remove work from Student government committee.

Adison: How about pro-temp and one student government committee member on hiring committee

Teaghan/ Eliza: sounds like a good plan

Adison: I will draft bill for after override.
