- a. [SB 84.04 “Records Access, Transparency, and Administrative Reform Bill”](#)
  - We are hiring the records clerk by the 19th so this might not go into effect for this year
  - Why is the records clerk no longer the primary point of contact for the OGC?
  - The JC appointment is pretty similar now but this might slow down the process
    - The process being slower could be good because their term is long
  - Increased transparency for public meeting is a good thing
  - Agree that the Records Clerk/Archivist should be independent
  - Maybe have summer hours for these positions

- Wouldn't be that much change in the budget
  - Amendment about public comment
    - 1. C. All meetings of the ASOSU Student Government held publicly shall include at least two portions reserved for gallery comment, with at least one portion prior to and at least one following the items of regular new and old business. Gallery members may also submit written comments prior to the meeting.
  - Amendment about how the SFC member should be decided -> Should an at-large seat become vacant, a committee comprising the **concurrent members of the Senate Student Government Committee (or other corresponding committee, as determined by the Senate)** in addition to the ASOSU President, SFC Chair, **and** SFC Vice Chair, **(or and another at-large member of the SFC)** (as designated by the SFC chair, confirmed by the at-large members of the SFC) shall open applications for and nominate a qualified individual to serve for the remainder of the term of office, subject to confirmation by the Senate.
  - b. Reviewing [SB 83.23 "ASOSU Code of Conduct"](#)
    - Pressure is not necessarily the best term
    - ASOSU doesn't need to be mandated to report OSU code of conduct reports
    - Read before next meeting
    - Receive OGC comments
  - c. Creation of ASOSU Public Official Ethics & Requirements Guide
    - a. Public Meeting Law -> Pearson and Rowe
    - b. Public Records Requests -> Eckman and Hostetler-McLaughlin
    - c. Free Speech Compliance -> Kowash
    - d. Additional Subjects
  - Emails could be subject to public meeting law, could run by the OGC
  - Where does free speech apply in the ASOSU?
  - How is student government set up in the law?
