Representative O'Donnell had a meeting with stakeholders two weeks ago, and though this initiative is supported, regulations surrounding city council and contributions keep extending the timeline. ASOSU President Paola is the primary contact regarding finalization of the incident fee. Current plan is to have bikes on campus in Winter 2024.

Will likely need to create a Qualtrics survey to assess student body interest in addition to contacting Recreational Sports. If there is a need that is documented, draft a resolution, or get them to consider this for FY25.
