**Minutes:**

Agenda–approved.

Sen. Alto brought up concerns from the Senate about a lack of progress from the CIC.

Appointment of a committee leader: No objections to Sen. Alto (unanimous consent)

CIC SC1 meeting time will remain at 3:00pm on Sundays, but can be subject to change. In-person meetings are also an option but for the foreseeable future will remain on zoom.

Ongoing projects for SC1:

- Rep Rang: Bee Campus certification. Reaching out to U of O about how they began their program.
- Rep. O'Donnell: Bike security. Contacted head of transportation for City of Corvallis, waiting on a response. Brought up how bike security is important to many students on-campus.
  - Options for bike security
    - Floodlights in storage areas
    - Distribution of locks
    - Internal storage areas
- Eco2Go– unsure where to start. Rep. O'Donnell in contact with Sen. Xander. Make contact with UHDS, Tobi Davies from exec. Reps. O'Donnell and Krecklow will lead further progress for this initiative.

Discussion from Rep. Shah:

In SharePoint, tasks can be sent out to the committees. Rep. Shah will be sending out tasks through there soon.

Brought up the idea of sending out a mass poll to get an idea of how many students could need high-quality bike locks, and then use the information to determine a number we could potentially source. For funding, reach out to businesses and see if we can get any donations, look into possible grants, or other ASOSU funding? Initially try to source 100-200 for a pilot launch. Recommended Qualtrics as the platform for the poll. Focusing on bike locks is a more achievable task than the installation of floodlights or structural improvements to bike storage areas.

Focus on bike security for now, but keep contacts in mind for all other projects.

Rep. Shah will work on helping compiling contacts for SC1.

Initiatives like Bee Campus or Eco2Go will take more time, so reach out to Rep. Shah or Xander if needed for consultations.

Sen. Alto will be working on the Bike Security project and the Qualtrics poll. Asked SC1 to reach out to students and gain general ideas/feelings about initiatives like bike security.

Rep. Shah will also work on the poll. The goal is to have it completed soon and able to be distributed during tabling events and State of the Students address later this week.

Rep. Shah suggested focusing only on 1-2 initiatives at a time, and setting feasible goals.
