“ASOSU Sustainability Index Request: Shared Micromobility Student Subsidy”

SUMMARY

This Resolution seeks to allocate \$46,517 of the ASOSU Sustainability Index (MGV 371) to provide student ride subsidies for the incoming shared micromobility program on the OSU Corvallis campus, expected to begin Fall 2024.

- WHEREAS** The ASOSU Sustainability Initiatives Index funding established by HB13.18 (2022)¹ provides opportunities for “funding for environmental sustainability initiatives,” and specifies that, “This Congress shall vote to approve the final allocation for each expense, unless it establishes an alternate process for the approval”;
- WHEREAS** In order to access the funding reserved for Sustainability Initiatives, the MG371 index must be overspent so that funds may be drawn from the ASOSU fund balance.
- WHEREAS** Since the passage of HR 14.03², *Campus Improvements Committee Continuation of Bike Share*, the ASOSU has partnered with transportation services and invited a vendor to provide a shared micromobility service to the OSU Corvallis Campus;
- WHEREAS** The ASOSU would like to subsidize student rides within this program so that the service is more accessible for students, while also incentivizing students to use sustainable transportation;
- WHEREAS** The shared micromobility program is a project encouraging sustainable transportation on campus, thus this subsidy could be applicably funded through the ASOSU Sustainability index.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE ASOSU THAT:


