III. Task Force Director Updates

- a. Accessibility Affairs
 - i. As you all know I have wanted to focus my efforts towards bringing awareness to invisible disabilities here at the university. If any of you attended the Universal Design seminar during our work training you would have noticed that there is a considerable amount of students here at OSU that struggle with a learning, hearing, vision or physical disability.
 - 1. Accessibility To Me Is... a great time to inform students, but what do you guys think would be a good tactic for gaining attention and leaving an impact
 - 2. Successful and Struggling - show pictures of famous people ask for the what they all have in common and then point out their disability
 - ii. The campus mapping project was started by predecessor Jonathan, and has yet to be touched. However I have reached out to Martha, I will be reaching out to Gabe and hopefully get the ball rolling with a CS grad student who could do the mapping as a senior project
 - 1. The end goal is to have an immediate map that can direct both abled bodied, and those with disabilities to wherever they need to go within a building
 - 2. The reality of a map app is far fetched by obtainable if funding was present. Ideas?
 - 3. Maps in different languages would be tight too. It's already hard enough for people from different countries to navigate campus from what I've gathered. Devin?

CJ Philips of Pi Kappas started a chapter of the Best Buddies® it is a nonprofit organization dedicated to establishing a global volunteer movement that creates opportunities for one-to-one friendships, integrated employment and leadership development for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities,
